

HAPPY NEW YEAR!

At this time of year, it is normal for us to take on New Year's resolutions. We do this each year, and while it is natural for us to focus on the physical because we can measure our progress in terms of money in the bank, debt paid down or pounds lost, etc. our Holy Father reminds us not to forget the spiritual aspect of our lives. We are especially called to do this during this *Year of* Faith Pope Benedict has invited us into. Because we are matter and spirit, we need to an approach that tackles both body and soul.

How do we further the development of the life of faith? This is not an easy question to answer, but it is an important question to ask. Because in asking the question, we acknowledge we are a work in progress and not a finished project. In fact, there is no such thing as a completely mature, completely fulfilled Christian. In this life we are constantly called to conversion, and will never be finished until we are home in heaven.

In this conversion walk, we need guidelines. One that will serve us well no matter which sphere of life we are developing comes from St. Paul's letter to the Romans: "let nothing separate you from the love of Christ" (Romans 8:35). If we follow this principal, no matter what comes our way; good or bad, success or failure, they can draw us closer to Christ. Often we put our own spin on things, and this is not bad. But what happens when we fail or when bad things happen? These things do not mean God has withdrawn, they do not mean that God doesn't care about us or our loved ones. With this as a guide we can challenge ourselves, setting goals that will stretch us in every way, always certain that ultimately God is in charge, and He desires only one thing; our salvation.

DIOCESAN APPEAL UPDATE

Congratulations. This has been a record year in terms of the time needed to meet our goal and the percentage of our families that have participated. We met the goal of \$35,839 in about 4 weeks. We also have had just over 34% of our families respond to date. In the years past, we have had around 25% respond, so this is a healthy sign of our parish life. With this response, we should not have an increase in what we ask next year. We will continue to strive to increase the percentage of those responding, however. If we can increase this to a respectable 75% to 80%, which can be done (I have seen over 95% at 3 different parishes) we can continue with successful campaigns. Remember, it is still not too late to participate. All responses are welcome, no matter what the contribution. If you are in need of a reply card, let the office know and we will get one out to you.
