SACRED HEART OF JESUS

Traditionally the month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the Catholic Church worldwide. In light of this, our Family Life Committee has asked that the option be available for a parish wide enthronement of homes to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. You will have the opportunity to receive a packet at our June 8-9 weekend Masses, but it might be good to get a deeper understanding of this devotion. In the past, many of our bishops have encouraged this devotion throughout our diocese, but it may have been awhile since it was presented here.

What is this devotion? The word 'enthrone' means "to put upon a throne." When we enthrone Jesus as King and Head of our home, we are turning our lives and hearts over to Him to draw closer every day. This is an important goal as set forth by the Pope in this Year of Faith. In our Consecration to Mary, we also deepen our relationship with Jesus, her Son, and gain grace and blessings through her love and heavenly intercession.

Why is it so important? Jesus said to St. Margaret Mary, "I will bless the homes in which an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored." To invite Jesus and Mary into our homes takes on greater meaning today in these troubled times, and become a source of daily devotion and grace.

The Devotion: For all Catholic men and women, families and young people troubled by the many afflictions of modern life, discover the greatest source of spiritual and temporal help, graces and blessings for those who truly love the Sacred Heart of Our Lord, Jesus Christ, and practice His requested Devotion with the essential prayers and acts, including the "First Friday" and the "Nine Fridays" promises.

"And He showed me that it was His great desire of being loved by men and of withdrawing them from the path of ruin into which Satan hurls such crowds of them, that made Him form the design of manifesting His Heart to men, with all the treasures of love, of mercy, of grace, of sanctification and salvation which it contains, in order that those who desire to render Him and procure for Him all the honor and love possible, might themselves be abundantly enriched with those divine treasures of which this Heart is the source.

He should be honored under the figure of this Heart of flesh, and its image should be exposed...He promised me that wherever this image should be exposed with a view to showing it special honor,
