Next weekend is the nonperishable food collection for our local food pantry. There are containers in the back of both churches for this monthly collection. Thank you to all who support this worthy cause.



How do we "come to our senses" and find inner joy and peace from the Lord?

Jesus teaches us about God's mercy and forgiveness in the parable of the Prodigal Son. We can relate to the lost son's experiences of unhappiness and loss of peace when we walk away from the love of our Heavenly Father through sin. We can "come to our senses" and regain inner joy and peace through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Let's take a closer look.

On the Fourth Sunday of Lent, the Church observes what is commonly known as Laetare Sunday or "Rejoice Sunday, from words taken from the entrance antiphon for this Mass: "Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her."

It's fitting that on this Laetare or "Rejoice" Sunday— marking the midpoint of Lent—we should have heard this particular Gospel, this beautiful story: the parable of the Prodigal Son. It is an occasion for rejoicing to see how he was lost but "comes to his senses" and returns home. It is a most stirring and emotional parable; in fact, we can say it's perhaps the best known and most loved of the Lord's parables.

In this parable, of course, we see how the young man, filled with himself, truly insults his father when he goes to him and says, "Give me my share of the inheritance." In other words: "To me, you are dead. I don't want to wait until you actually are dead—I want my money now." So it's a pronounced insult to the father, yet the father acquiesces to the young man's request, and off the son goes.

Of course, as the Lord so movingly relates, the young man loses all of his money and is left destitute. But he "comes to his senses." What a wonderful phrase that is: "coming at last to his senses." The son returns to his father in humility, and he is restored fully to his father's good grace. This is an act of the father, the loving father, who welcomes him back and even runs out to meet him.

This parable, this beautiful parable of the prodigal son—or, you might better say of the "merciful father"— is so rightly and fittingly placed here in the midst of the Lenten season: this halfway point, when we have desired—by our works of penance, prayer, fasting, and almsgiving—to conform our hearts and our lives more perfectly to the Lord. And here we have this beautiful story of forgiveness of the father.

So this parable is given not just to those scribes and Pharisees of 2000 years ago, but to us today. It is given to you and to me, so that we can return to our Heavenly Father humbly and confess our sins, after "coming to our senses" and recognizing our sins. We might then be fully restored through the Sacrament of Penance to the right relationship with God, finding inner joy and peace so that, like the Prodigal Son, we who are dead might be given life, that we who have been.
