



Father Walijewski's cause for beatification to be announced

At the Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman, on March 19, 2013 – the Feast of St. Joseph – Bishop William P. Callahan will announce the opening of the Cause for Beatification and Canonization of Father Joseph A. Walijewski. Dr. Andrea Ambrosi, the postulator for the cause, will travel from Rome to participate. One traditional element that will occur is the posting of the edict announcing the cause on the doors of the cathedral. The edict must state that anyone who can offer testimony, good or bad, about the Servant of God must make themselves known to the tribunal so they may give their testimony.

Seven months after his installation as the bishop of the Diocese of La Crosse, Bishop Callahan visited Casa Hogar Juan Pablo II in Lima, Peru, for the 25th anniversary of the orphanage started by Father Jose. After seeing the fruit of the seeds planted at the orphanage and learning that Father Jose also created Holy Cross Parish at Santa Cruz, Bolivia, Bishop Callahan decided to start the cause for Father Jose. On the last evening during his visit at Casa Hogar, following a candle light prayer service, Bishop Callahan pointed to Father Jose's grave and said "Now we will work for him."

Father Walijewski was ordained April 16, 1950, by Bishop John Patrick Treacy. He initially served as an assistant pastor in Mosinee, Thorp and Stevens Point. In 1956, Father Jose was released from his diocesan duties to go to Santa Cruz. On arrival, he was given a machete by Bishop Charles Brown, MM, auxiliary of the Diocese of Santa Cruz. The two of them hacked through the tropical grass until Bishop Brown said, "Build a church here and the people will come and build their homes next to it."

In 1966 Father Jose returned to the Diocese of La Crosse at the request of Bishop Frederick Freking. He served at St. John Parish in Heffron, Guardian Angels Parish in Almond and St. Martin Parish in Buena Vista; and was the pastor at St. Hedwig Parish in Thorp. In 1971 he returned to South America, this time to Lima, Peru, a region that had been struck by an earthquake. On arrival, he was named the pastor of a new barrio on the outskirts of Lima called Villa El Salvador. He built a church and eight outlying chapels for the ever-increasing population. He also organized breakfast stations throughout the city that fed 8,000 children a day.

In 1987, with the help of a \$50,000 donation from Pope John Paul II, he started Casa Hogar in Lima, Peru. Father Jose knew that the two most important things these abandoned children needed was a relationship with Jesus Christ and a family structure.

(continued from first column) He provided the first through the sacraments and the second by having the children live six to seven in an apartment with a man and a woman who would teach them family skills.

In 2000 Father Jose turned the orphanage over to a younger priest, Father Sebastian Kolodziejczyk, also of the Diocese of La Crosse. Father Jose, who was 76, was not done. He moved to Oxapampa, Peru, where he lived at a house with adults that had grown up at Casa Hogar. He helped establish a home for the elderly to be staffed by consecrated women religious and drove into the rain forest on Sundays to celebrate Mass for the small communities of Ashiko Indians.

Father Jose died as he wished – while working among the poor. He was taken to a hospital in Lima where he passed away of pneumonia and acute leukemia on April 11, 2006.
