

SCRIP: What graduate doesn't need some gas money, a card for their favorite fast food joint, some new books (Amazon) or iTunes? All of these and more make great gifts, and are available at your parish offices and after most Masses at Holy Family. The way these work, is basically they are purchases at a discount that varies from 3% to 15% or even 20%. One card that is very popular is the Kwik Trip card that offers a 10% discount. Think of it as a way to give \$10.00 to your parish for every \$100 you put in the car. There are Scrip cards for everything from groceries to remodeling to restaurants and almost everything in between.

There is one thing we are trying to clear up concerning SCRIP, and that is that this is a school program: I don't have kids or grandkids in Catholic school, so I shouldn't need to worry about using SCRIP. In reality, there is nothing further from the truth. SCRIP benefits the entire parish, not just the school. If needed, we can earmark the profits that come in to any specific project the finance council desires. Please consider purchasing SCRIP to benefit your parish. We realize it does take pre-planning, but it goes to a worth-while cause.
