

There is a meditation on the Seven Last Words of Christ that is a popular meditation. Fr Roman Cessario, O.P. has put together a short essay on each of these seven Last Words. Each week during Lent we will offer Fr. Cessario's reflection as a guide for our Lenten journey. It is my prayer that these short meditations will help deepen your pilgrimage this year. THE FIRST WORD: I THIRST

From the wood of a cross sanctified by his blood, God's own son expresses the purpose of his becoming man. Jesus, one like us in all things but sin, thirsts for the souls of those he came to save. That is, every person on earth, beginning with Adam. Jesus wants to love us and wants us to love him in return. So he thirsts. The thirst that Jesus experiences at his death endures throughout the ages. This last word of Jesus provides a first word for every Christian. No one should begin a day without remembering before all else that Jesus thirsts for his or her soul. 'We love because he first loved us' (1 Jn 4:19). The priority of the divine initiative takes on human expression in the words of a thirsty, dying man.

CLOSING PRAYER: AD JESUM PER MARIAM: To Jesus through Mary. To learn well the divine truths that Jesus speaks to us from the cross, join the company of the Virgin Mother of God, Mary Immaculate. Let Mary open your hearts to hear whatever Jesus would tell you. As she herself instructs us: Do whatever he tells you (Jn 2:5). In the Name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen

AN EXPERIMENT

This Lent, I would like to offer an option at St. John's church. It is something some of my priest friends have done or we have seen in various locations throughout the church in our world today. There is a movement in many areas to go to kneeling to receive Holy Communion, and in order to see where our local community is in regards to this, we will place a double Prex Deux in the front of St John's church. The faithful will have the option of standing or kneeling, and the option of receiving on the hand or on the tongue will remain as well. In other words, you may kneel and receive in the hands or on the tongue, or you may stand and receive either in the hands or on the tongue. We will review this practice after Lent to see whether or not the community desires to continue or not.
