#### PROJECT UPDATE

**Parish Hall:** With the annual fish fry coming up very quickly, the hall and kitchen have seen much progress in the last couple of months. As of this writing, the plastering of the walls has been completed; the drop ceiling, the electrical and the bathroom fixtures are moving forward as well. The kitchen plumbing, ventilation and cabinetry are progressing nicely. The kitchen floor has been finished, and the main floor will be finished by the end of this month. While there remains much to be completed and a good cleaning will be required before the first dinner, it is the intention of everyone involved that we host our Feb 26<sup>th</sup> Fish Fry in our new hall.

Gym / Day Care / Office Center: The majority of the exterior has been completed. Currently the main focus is on the hall, but work continues here as well. The windows are all installed, as are most of the exterior doors. Interior walls, electrical, insulation (90% finished) are all current works in progress.
