The great feasts of Christmas and Easter have passed, along with the preparations of Advent and Lent, This can be comparable to our family life: we all have special days of events that we celebrate throughout the year, and at times there are other one-time events such as a family wedding or birth of a child into a family. We are celebrating something like that during this Extra-Ordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy. It would be good to keep this in mind as we enter into the summer season as well. What is the simplest thing we can do? Remember this year especially that we do not take a vacation from God when we take vacation with our families. With so many apps for our phones and the convenience of the internet, as you are planning a time away, whether it is a trip across the country or a weekend camping; where and when are we going to Mass? Be a missionary of Mercy for your family, and this Ordinary Time will be far from ordinary.
