### **PROCESSIONS**

Another change you might be aware of is the procession entering Mass and leaving Mass. At his Mass of thanksgiving, Dcn. Mark spoke about this, but as a reminder and for those that were not there, I will recap in this article. There ae liturgical guidelines for Masses, some of which change depending on the ministers in attendance. In fact, there is an entire book dedicated to celebrating with a bishop.

One of these guidelines concerns processions in the Mass. They state that the procession is to be with a Book of the Gospels. Here at Holy Family Parish, we have not had a Book of the Gospels since the new translation (I believe it was 2003). We have been processing with a Lectionary, which contains all the readings for a particular celebration. With a deacon now serving our parish, we have purchased a Book of the Gospel for each church.

The liturgical sense is the we are led into the celebration by the Word of God. The book is placed flat on the altar of sacrifice, and is carried to the Ambo to be proclaimed at the proper time by either the priest or deacon. At the end of the Mass, it has been the tradition here at Holy Family to have the lectionary carried out by the lector. This is another change that will be in effect. When we come into the Mass and hear the Word of God, we now hold His Word in our hearts. As we join in the recessional procession, we are to carry the Word with us into our homes, schools and businesses. Therefore, it does not make sense to symbolically carry the Book of the Gospel out, when we are literally carrying Him with us as we leave. In the absence of the deacon, the lector will carry the Book of the Gospel with them, and place it on the altar.

Hopefully this will give added meaning to the entrance and recessional processions, and help us see some of the deeper meaning behind what we do. Having these explained helps us see that everything we do and say at the Mass has a many levels of meaning.
