## Catholic Q & A

**Q.** Is there a proper way to genuflect? Right knee, left knee? Both knees?

Brad, Stamford, Conn.

**A.** Here is a reply from Father Francis Hoffman, J.C.D.:

Ordinarily, we should genuflect in the presence of the sacred with our right knee; the faithful can do a double genuflection (both knees) in the presence of the Most Blessed Sacrament exposed in the monstrance, or in the presence of a first-class relic of the Holy Cross.

**Q.** How long to wait to eat before/after Communion?

**A.** Since Christianity's earliest days, pious practices and Church legislation have dealt with the timing of eating or drinking before or after receiving holy Communion. Current Church law requires a one-hour fast before receiving holy Communion, as canon 909 states. And although there is no requirement of refraining from food after reception of the sacrament, there are a variety of longstanding, pious practices that aim at **reverence** for the real presence of Christ in the holy Eucharist – such as waiting until the Eucharist has natural dissolved (about 15 minutes) or consuming a glass of water to flush one's system.
