# **HOLY WEEK**

This week begins our Holy Week celebration. This is the holiest week of our year as Catholic Christians, as we accompany Christ spiritually in his passion, death and resurrection. Lent officially ends on Thursday, but that is also the beginning of the Sacred Triduum (Sacred 3 days) which is a time of even deeper penitence and prayer. Today we celebrate Palm Sunday, the day Jesus enters triumphantly into Jerusalem, to the cries of 'Hosanna, Hosanna in the Highest'. These cries suddenly turn to 'Crucify Him, Crucify Him' on Good Friday. On Tuesday we celebrate the Chrism Mass with the bishop at 10:30 in La Crosse. At this Mass the bishop consecrates all the Holy Oils used throughout the coming year for various sacraments, including all baptisms, confirmations, Holy Orders and Anointing of the Sick. All are invited, so if you are able, please come to La Crosse for this celebration. This is also the Mass that the priests in the diocese renew their priestly promises. On holy Thursday we celebrate the installation of the Eucharist, or the Mass of the Last Supper. Good Friday is a celebration of the Passion of Christ, leading to Holy Saturday, the 1 day in the year we do not celebrate a Mass in the Church. Saturday evening, after sunset, we have the Easter Vigil, with the blessing of light and the New Easter Candle, followed by the resurrection of our Lord on Easter Sunday morning. This Easter celebration is so important; we celebrate for 8 days. Each day has a different perspective of the Resurrection, and culminates with Divine Mercy Sunday, which is the day we celebrate 1st Holy Communion with our 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade class. In addition to these, at 7:00 pm on Wednesday our youth group will present Live Stations of the Cross at John's Church and at 8:00 pm on Friday evening a Tenebrae (shadows) service will be held at St. John's.

# WELCOME HOME

With the Easter season fast approaching, this is a beautiful time to welcome back to the practice of the faith those who have been away for any reason. I would like to encourage you to reach out to a family member, to a loved one or to a neighbor you may know who has not been actively practicing his or her faith with an invitation to join you at the Easter Mass this year. Although, you may not be able to invite them to receive Holy Communion, they are always welcome to join in the celebration of the Mass. There are so many reasons one stops practicing their faith, and there are some legitimate reasons we should refrain from receiving Holy Communion at a particular time. In today's day, these two things often are confused with each other. The Gospel calls

ing Holy Communion at a particular time. In today's day, these two things often are confused with each other. The Gospel calls us to *keep holy the Sabbath*; we are not necessarily called to receive Holy Communion at each Mass we attend. As Catholics we keep the Sabbath by attending the sacrifice of the Mass on Saturday evening or on Sunday. While we should do all we can in order to receive Holy Communion in a worthy fashion (without serious sin on our conscience, being in a valid marriage, observing the fast, etc), the most important aspect is worshipping God by our physical presence at the sacrifice of the Mass.
