April 3, 2022 5th Sunday of Lent

Here is the latest update on the 2021 Diocesan Annual Appeal in relation to our parish: As of **3/29/2022**, the pledged to date is **\$58,190** which is **87.58%** of the target from **218** parish households out of approximately 750. There is **\$8,255** left to pledge. We need the support from all our parishioners to at least reach and exceed the target. Any money over the target is returned to the parish to support the parish budget. When you send in your pledge card and/or donation, you can send it directly to the diocese.

Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday are days to abstain from eating meat from age 14 and up. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days to fast which means eating one full meal with the other two equaling another meal for Catholics from age 18 up to 59.

There will be a box at each church for you to deposit old palms in preparation for Palm Sunday until May 1st. Since palms are blessed, they should not be thrown into the garbage. You can either return them to church, or burn and bury them yourself.

A copy of the St. Gabriel and Calvary Cemetery Regulations is available in the back of both Churches.
