Here is the latest update on the 2021 Diocesan Annual Appeal in relation to our parish: As of **6/22/2022**, the pledged to date is **\$67,810** which is **102.05%** of the target from **250** parish households out of approximately 750. We have met and exceeded our target amount! Thank you very much to all our parishioners who donated. The amount over the target will be returned to the parish to support the parish budget.

Father Honore Kombo from the Democratic Republic of Congo will speak at all the Masses in our Parish on the weekend of June 25-26, 2022 on behalf of his Diocese of Kikwit in the Congo as part of the Mission Co-op. The Diocese of Kikwit has recently celebrated its Centenary of Evangelization (2012-2017). Building on milestones of over 100 years of Evangelization, they take on the challenges to continue the work of the Mission today. Father Kombo will give the missionary appeal in support to the pastoral work of 194 Diocesan Priests, to help equip 5 most important diocesan hospitals with medicines and other basic health supplies, and to give children from very poor families an opportunity for education. Envelopes will be in the pews or you can use any envelope as long as is marked for the mission co-op; please be generous. When you give your donation, please make the check payable to Holy Family Parish. The parish will issue one check to the diocesan mission office at its request once all donations are expected.
