
Mark your calendar: Fr. Paul Fagan will present a video presentation on Tuesday, September 4th at 7:00 pm in St. John's School.

FALL PREPERATIONS

It seems like every year, around this time, we begin to make plans for fall. This year is no different. Whether we are prepared or not, school will soon be here and fall parish programs such as RCIA and CCD will be started. It is good to ask ourselves, where am I in regards to any of these things:

School: If you have children in pre-K to 8th grade, I hope you had a chance to listen to the presentation this weekend. Parents are the first educators of their children, and it does make a difference where you send your children to school. A good education is far more than learning how to do the 3 R's; a good education prepares a person to live in this world while preparing them for the next life, eternal life. Speaking openly about God, bringing our faith into every moment of the day, into all the varying curriculums; these are things that the public system just can't do. It is in these areas that Prairie Catholic can offer an education not only for this world, but for eternity.

But you may say that I do not have children or children this age. As a member of Holy Family Parish, Prairie Catholic School is still part of your life as it is our largest parish outreach. We are constantly looking for people to support our libraries, tech programs or other areas in the school. In these difficult economic days for many, a donation to Care and Share is always appreciated as well.

CCD: This is a much needed program that is always searching for assistance. This program is for our children that just cannot enroll at Prairie Catholic for one reason or another. Although this program limits how much contact we have with the young people, we do our best to have qualified teachers and a quality curriculum for our young people. If you might be interested in helping in one way or another, contact our CCD coordinator for details.

RCIA: The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. This is an important program that is constantly being evaluated to see how effective it is, and to help those interested in becoming Catholic. It is also a great way for those Catholics who just want a more solid foundation for their faith lives. This year, we will be offering RCIA on Sunday mornings during the 10:00 Mass. It will be about an hour class, so if you have a spouse interested in learning more about the faith or perhaps a child that has been away and is looking for the path, let them know about this. There will be informational meetings in the near future for this as well. Please let anyone you know that might be interested know of these meetings. It is sometimes a difficult subject to broach because we never know what their response might be; but we do know their response if they are never asked.
