#### **ADVENT 2012**

What a difference a year makes. At this time last year, we were in the planning stages for the merging of St. John's and St. Gabriel into Holy Family Parish. It was also the first Sunday of Advent that we began using the new translation of the Roman Missal. These two milestones in our parish life and in the faith life of the Church in the English speaking world in less than a year's time span will be long remembered here in Prairie du Chien. What will this year bring? We never know, but we can be sure that if we continue to walk with open hearts, the Holy Spirit has untold gifts in store.

This year has been designated as the Year of Faith by Pope Benedict XVI. So, we have the opportunity to celebrate an Advent of Faith for the next 4 weeks leading up to Christmas. Bringing our liturgical year to a close changes the tone of the readings at Mass. For the last month or so we have been looking at the last 4 things; death, judgment, heaven and hell. Four realities all of us will face at some point or another. These lead us to reflect on the meaning of Advent; preparing our hearts for the birth of Jesus Christ. Not just any old birthday, a day to remember the past year, but for a true birth of Christ in our hearts so we can be his witness into the world. This can only be done in faith. To help begin our Advent of Faith, I offer the following meditations on the first mystery of the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary from The Magnificat Year of Faith booklet:

The Annunciation: The Blessed Virgin Mary received the Word of God in deep humility and obedience. May I share in our Lady's faith so as to be ever open to the will of God and to the re-creation brought forth by his Holy Word. Come, Holy Spirit-come through Mary into my life to perfect it and to sanctify it. God bless. Fr. Jim
