Why do we need a Savior?

A Savior has come to us as a baby, born in a manger, in the small town of Bethlehem. This Savior comes to restore us to friendship with God, a friendship we cannot re-establish on our own, but which requires God's action. Let's take a closer look.

In these days surrounding Christmas we will hear the proclamation of the Angel to the shepherds "I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For today in the City of David a Savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord." Jesus is born as the Christ, the Anointed One of God, who brings salvation to His people. The name Jesus itself means "God saves."

Salvation is the restoration of friendship with God. The constant teaching of the Bible is that this friendship was lost by the sin of Adam and Eve. We need to have God restore that friendship because we cannot do it on our own. Even a human friendship is a freely bestowed gift. If I betray my friend's trust I would lose all "rights" to that friendship. I may recognize I've done something wrong and may try to repair the broken relationship, but I cannot restore it on my own. The friendship can only be restored by my friend's forgiveness and mercy. If this is the case with human friendship, how much more is it true of the lost friendship with God?

Any action which will restore us to God's friendship must come first from God. That's why we need a Savior. We can't do it on our own. Jesus is born in a manger so that we might understand that it is God's love we are in need of and that God willingly provides that love when He sends us His Son, Jesus Christ. It is so commonly part of all the world's religions that certainly it is wired into our human nature that we strive to commune with God.

With Jesus Christ, God reverses that usual searching of humanity for God and instead God comes to us. So the Angel says, "I proclaim to you good news of great joy." God wants to restore friendship with us. God wants to set things right. God wants us to live our lives to their fullest here and now and enjoy his friendship for eternity.

The novelty of Christmas is not that a baby is born, but that this Child born in Bethlehem is the very presence of God's love come into the world so that all who believe in Him might have eternal life. Jesus is the Savior whom we need because in Him is the grace necessary for us to overcome all of the dysfunction, sinfulness, shame and guilt which separates us from God and from one another. In Him is the grace to overcome all obstacles to friendship with God. In Bethlehem "a Savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord."
