

# THANK YOU

Thank you to all who gave of your Sunday afternoon to spend some time discussing the future of our parish in Prairie Du Chien. These town hall meetings are important for a variety of reasons as they help build a cohesive identity, they bring us together as a family and they are an opportunity for us to avoid rumors and false information so we can speak the truth to friends and neighbors who were not able to be with us. There were some good ideas that came from this meeting, and I hope

The primary topic was to get a consensus for the name of our new parish. The top two were Holy Family and All Saints, which you will have voted on by the time you read this. Both of these titles would give us a particular feast day in the Liturgical calendar, and will be a meaningful title to unite our parishes. We will be making a recommendation to the diocesan planning committee and Bishop Callahan soon.

On another note, we all know Lent is fast approaching. (Ash Wednesday is Feb 22) As with any important event in our lives, pre-planning is necessary to have a good start. If we wait until Ash Wednesday to begin thinking about what we would like to do, we will fall into the old trap of not starting anything for a week or two. By the time we get into our Lenten practices, it is 1/3 or even  $\frac{1}{2}$  over. I would like to make a suggestion: Adoration. There is no shortage of things that need our prayers, from the HHS decision Bishop Callahan wrote about last week, to the shortage of priests (the primary reason to merge our parishes), to the many members of our families suffering from various illnesses, to the health of our school, to any number of things we face on a daily basis. With this in mind, after discussions with those that administer our Thursday Adoration times, we would like to offer one 24 hour period of adoration per week during Lent. In order to do this, we need to be assured that there will be someone accompanying our Lord the entire time. Right now we are working out the details, but there should be sign-up sheets available by next weekend. This schedule will be broken down into 1 hour segments. If you or your family would care to join in this effort, please write in your name in one of these slots. You may also contact one of the parish offices if that is more convenient. This would be a beautiful sacrifice we can offer to God that has been proven over and over again to deepen our personal relationship with Him. Please give this prayerful consideration as we prepare for this holy time of Lent and Easter. God bless
