#### UPDATE ON DIOCESAN APPEAL

Congratulations to all on another successful diocesan appeal, and thank you for your continuous expression of faith in me as your pastor. This is the third year running that we have attained the goal we have been given at both St John's and St. Gabriel's. This year we have published the list of donors as a means of thanking those who are participating, and we also have the list posted in the churches. Currently, around 25% of registered members at St Gabriel's have responded along with around 32% of St John's members. This remains the number one priority in this appeal; how do we encourage those who do not participate?

As a reminder, this drive goes through June, so it is not too late to become a part of this important program with your fellow parishioners. As we have now met our goal, 100% of any additional donations coming in through the appeal are sent directly to the parish (in comparison, .70 of each dollar of normal collections are retained, with .30 going to the diocese), and commitment cards are available at the parish offices.
