



Holy Family Update

As I mentioned at the Masses last weekend, Bishop Callahan has approved the name of Holy Family for our parish here in Prairie du Chien. This helps us continue moving forward on this, as the 1st of July will be here before we know it, and there is much to be accomplished. The next step is 2 meetings, one for each parish. These next meetings will take place on Wednesday, March 21, 2012. Please check the bulletin next week for the times and locations. There is one difference for these next meetings; the one held at St Gabriel will be for St Gabriel parishioners, and the one held at St. John's will be for St. John's parishioners. These will be opportunities to speak about any concerns you might have as we move forward. After this, we will again have joint meetings to bring our entire community together so everything can be addressed.

Lenten Programs

We are in the midst of our Lenten programs at our parish as well. The 2 Faith Alive groups are well attended and moving along. If you have the time open and are interested, it is not too late to get involved. Simply show up at one of the meetings and begin. The new men's group is off to a good start, with more than 10 men getting together on Thursday mornings. This is a group that will shift course a bit following Easter, and all men (non-Catholics as well) are welcome. Where this group goes will be determined by the group itself; we would love to see you there.

You may have noticed that there will be a Seder Meal this Lent as well, and may be wondering what a Seder meal is. It is an opportunity to share in a traditional Passover meal, and see how the roots of our faith are tied to the Jewish faith. There will be a Jewish Rabbi in attendance to explain the religious significance and meaning to the various aspects of the meal.

We will also have our **Tenebrae** service at night on Good Friday. This can be a powerful experience of the passion, death and burial of Christ. It is a simple candlelight program with readings from sacred Scripture. This is a fairly short service, and has grown since we began holding it. We also have the normal Holy Week schedule, continuing the custom of the past few years of alternating between our 2 church buildings for the various services. Schedules will be in next week's bulletin.

You are in my prayers as we continue our Lenten journey.
