

There is some information concerning the school in this report as well, but please keep in mind the school endowment is a separate entity and the school has it's own accounting that is already together as Prairie Catholic Schools. Also, last week I had a meeting with Bishop Callahan, and he gave his approval for our parish name: Holy Family Parish. Please stay tuned as there will be some meetings coming up in the near future concerning this new venture.

Weekly Adoration: This seems to be going well. After a bump or two that are to be expected when beginning a new venture, I have heard many compliments and encouraging words about our 24 hour period of adoration. One change we will add is Benediction every week. On Saturdays with no funeral, we will then have the Holy sacrifice of the Mass at 8:00; if there is a funeral scheduled, there will be no 8:00 Mass. Please keep in mind that the sign up was for each Friday during Lent (except Good Friday - Holy Saturday). If you need a sub, there are lists posted in each church building. If you are interested in being a sub, please write your name and number on the sub list

Kindergarten Round-up: On Monday, March 19 we will be holding our kindergarten screening. If you are the parent or guardian of a child entering kindergarten, please keep this date in mind. This is a very important event for Prairie Catholic Schools, as it gives us an indication on enrollment for staffing decisions.
