

Notes Common to all Parishes

PENTECOST & MEMORIAL DAY

This is the traditional weekend that kicks off our summer season. I know that there are many of us looking forward to a bit more relaxed schedule, more outdoor activities and perhaps a bit of time off from work or school. This year we also celebrate the Feast of Pentecost the same weekend. A good question to ask ourselves: can the Feast of Pentecost help us to a better celebration of Memorial Day? I think the answer is a resounding 'Yes'.

Memorial Day is a time to remember all those that have sacrificed for our nation and for freedom. This Memorial Day we need to recall what freedom truly is, and where it comes from. Freedom is written into human nature, and for that reason our ancestors and nation have fought for our own freedom, and for others. Freedom is not about doing what we want when we want to do it; that is license. Freedom directs us toward the Truth and allows us to choose the truth. The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us: The more one does what is good, the freer one becomes. There is no true freedom except in the service of what is good and just. The choice to disobey and do evil is an abuse of freedom and leads to the 'slavery of sin.' (CCC 1731 -34)

Once we understand we are created in the image and likeness of God, that we are body and soul and we have the gift of reason and free will, we can begin to grasp the Church's teaching of freedom. The perfection of any being is to act in accord with its nature; and this gives glory to its creator. A dog simply being a dog gives God glory; a tree being a tree gives God glory etc. Human beings are the only creature that can freely choose to act in ways not in accord with their nature; we can turn from God and from our nature. However, this is an abuse of freedom and enslaves us rather than freeing us.

I think to understand what freedom is we need the gift of understanding and knowledge the Holy Spirit brings. To stand up to the abuses and attacks that have begun and will continue to come our way we will need the gifts of fortitude, fear of the Lord, and perseverance. To make persuasive arguments we will need the gifts of wisdom and counsel. Where the attacks of religious freedom leads, no one can be sure, but we are sure that there will be battles on this in the coming months, and we need to do our part to prepare for these.

So this Memorial Day, it is right and good to honor our ancestors, our brothers and sisters who have died so we may live in freedom; but we should also remember our Church and all those that have defended freedom and the dignity of the human person for over 2000 years. Come Holy Spirit! May God bless and watch over you and your loved ones this summer.
