Bishop-elect Flock

As you may have heard, Msgr. Robert Flock, a priest of the diocese of La Crosse has been named as an auxiliary bishop in Bolivia. We here in Prairie du Chien have a bit of a connection to this new bishop as well. His sister, Mrs. Jenny Wachuta, is our second grade teacher at Prairie Catholic school. This is a great honor for the Flock family, as well as an honor for the diocese of La Crosse. Msgr. Flock has served for many years in Bolivia at a parish served by our diocese that includes an orphanage as well, and he will now serve the people of the Archdiocese of Cochabamba. As an auxiliary bishop, he will be helping the archbishop in the running of the diocese. While the particular duties of an auxiliary bishop depend on the needs of the diocese it is very likely he will be named a bishop at some point. This appointment is a great opportunity for us to reflect on the Catholicity or universality of our faith. An American priest being named bishop in a Spanish speaking South American diocese points out that our faith is not dependent on a particular nation or even a particular language. Our faith, rather, goes beyond all borders and crosses every language barrier. It is about living the Gospel and being God's witnesses to the world, wherever that may take us. Please keep Bishop-elect Flock in your prayers.
