Remember there is no school on November 8th. Enjoy the day!

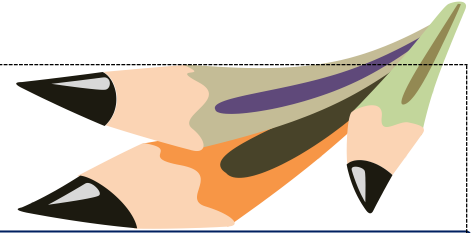
