Please welcome Richard Palucci!

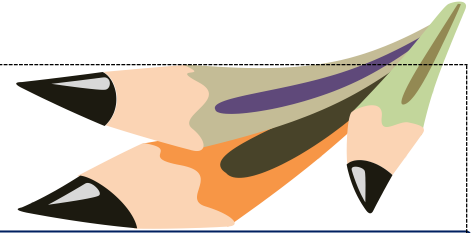
