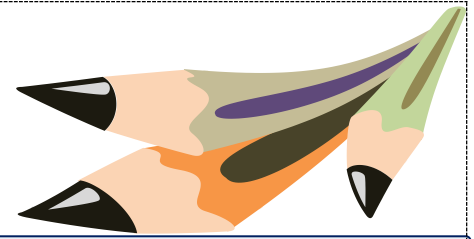
Congratulations Elle for being selected for the December Student of the Month!
