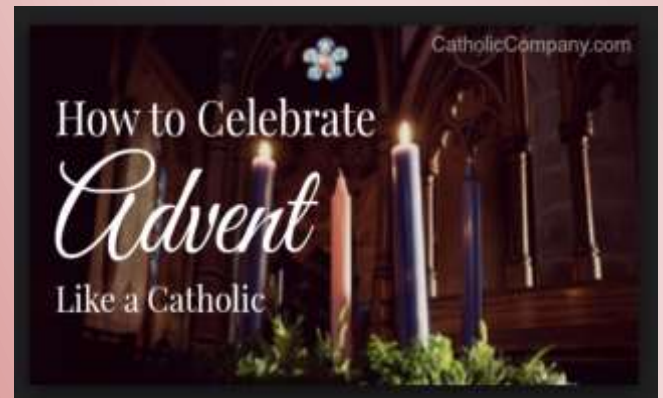
As my quarantine ends, I am excited to get back to work and see all the kiddos next week!

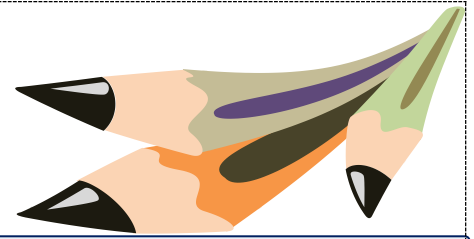
