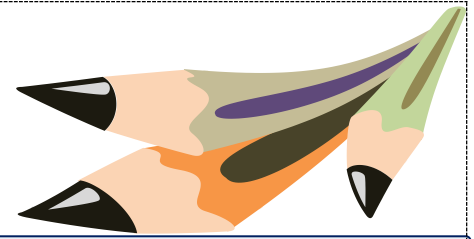
Congratulations to the following students for being selected for Student of the Month!
