

# Parish Council Minutes

## September 16, 2010

Members present: Pat Mercaitis, Jim McGrath, Steve Schwager, Father Weighner, Keith Neisius Mark Forsythe, and Mark Grunwald.

Missing: Holly Nicholson, Patrick Nolan, Kerri Weber.

Opened with prayer and roll call.

Minutes were read and approved

### Old Business:

- The update of sound systems is delayed because some of the equipment is on back order.
- A committee has been formed to build on and implement the Strategic Plan that was put together a few years ago. They will have their first meeting in October 2010. We expect them to come up with a longer range building and facilities plan.
  - Vision is for the PdC parishes to become one parish with 2 locations.
  - Building needs assessment and plan for the future, including whether or not we pursue building a gymnasium and any other building plans.
- Replacing members: We gave Father Weighner some more names to contact to see if they might be interested (Katie Fox and Charley Connell)
- You Program: Announcements will be made in the October bulletin for Net Team. It will be promoted for 8<sup>th</sup> graders on up to 12 graders. The retreat will be in November.

### New Business:

- Sunday Mass schedule will revert back to the winter schedule starting September 19<sup>th</sup>. (7:30 am at Gabes and 11:00 am at Johns)
- Education: Enrollment at PCS is basically the same as last year.
- Finance: For the first two months of the fiscal year, income is down around 5K at each parish.
  - School expenses had an increase of about \$13,800 mostly due to the technology upgrade.
  - We are in need of upgrading the lawn mowing equipment and the Cemetery will be selling some Railroad stock to use for purchasing lawn mowing equipment. Keith (last name?) found a used mower for \$2500 and will sell the use of it to the parish for \$1250.
- Family Life:
  - Members of Family Life were questioning why the parish council does not have a full roster. It was explained that we have not been successful in recruiting new members.
  - Family Life has recognized that Fr. Weighner has very heavy work load and is wondering if more things could be delegated to parishioners.
  - Family Life is inquiring whether there should be a separate "Sacred Worship" committee that would take care of Liturgical prayer programs (such as rosary) and planning of the Liturgy.
  - Youth ministry would fall under the responsibilities of Family Life, but they admit that they have not done much in this area.

Closed with prayer. Next meeting October 21, 2010.
