PENTECOST SUNDAY

VENI, SANCTE SPIRITUUS; COME, HOLY SPIRIT

This simple prayer is a very powerful invitation to open our hearts and allow the Holy Spirit to enter and fill us with the grace God offers. This prayer takes only a moment to say, and is especially powerful after receiving Holy Communion. When returning to your seat, take a minute to invite the Holy Spirit into your heart, into your struggles and into your joys. A quote attributed to St. Augustine states: *He who created us without our help will not save us without our consent.* God does not act as a steamroller over our lives. We need to open our hearts and invite him in. The feast of Pentecost is a good reminder of this. The Apostles waited in prayer for 9 days after the Ascension, waiting with open hearts to receive the promised Paraclete. He did not disappoint then; He will not disappoint today.

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

Twelve Promises of Jesus to Saint Margaret Mary

In the apparitions to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, Jesus gives these twelve promises for those who are devoted to His Sacred Heart.

1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their troubles.
4. They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death.
5. I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
10. I will give to priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.
