Please welcome Fr. John Parr who is covering this weekend! He has recently earned the status of a senior-priest of the diocese.

Here is the latest update on the 2021 Diocesan Annual Appeal in relation to our parish: As of **2/07/2022**, the pledged to date is **\$53,535** which is **80.57%** of the target from **204** parish households out of approximately 750. We need the support from all our parishioners to at least reach and exceed the target. Any money over the target is returned to the parish to support the parish budget. When you send in your pledge card and/or donation, you can send it directly to the diocese. Thank you very much to all those who have given thus far!

The pastoral council desires to have elections as stated in the diocesan directives on councils. According to the guidelines in these directives, two-thirds of the positions should be filled by election with the remaining one-third appointed. The Holy Family pastoral council has seven positions. In order to phase in the elections, two positions will be open this year for election. There should be four people running. The weekend for the elections is set for the weekend of April 30th-May 1st.

The pastoral council is one of two councils that parishes are to have with the other being the finance council. The pastoral council concerns itself with all aspects of the parish except finances and the temporal goods which is under the domain of the finance council. A person who can be placed on the slate is to be a registered member of the parish, supports the work of the Church and parish, and will work together for the best of the parish and not for oneself or one issue. One who is interested in being in the upcoming election must put it in writing and submitted to Msgr. Stoetzel by March 15th.

I embrace You as if You were already

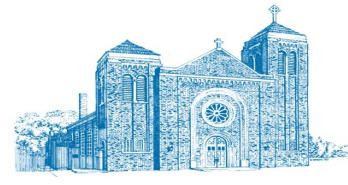
