Quarterly Report: Holy Family Cemetery Committee 5-2022

The Holy Family Cemetery Committee has been busy defining our projects for 2022. Two major projects are happening this summer. At Calvary, we are paving another section of roadway that goes out the North entrance to the cemetery. We need financial help to pave future sections of Calvary Roads. The second project is at St. Gabriel's Cemetery. We will be removing the deteriorating fence between St Gabriel's parking lot, north of the church, and the graveyard to the east. We will be installing parking bumpers between this row of parking and the cemetery. This should aid in St. Gabriel's appearance and snow removal in the winter.

Other projects for 2022 will be the placement of a Columbaria Brochure Holder near Columbaria Circle at Calvary. The Grotto at Calvary has previously had the nuisance vines removed. This year the two statues will be painted. As always a few of the parishioners maintain the flowers in the grotto area. Thanks for doing this! We will be removing the two large white urns at Calvary. We have tried to have them repaired but we were advised they are not salvageable. Circulating in the back of both churches (March to May) have been a set of new cemetery rules. We adopted these rules as of 5-2022. Large signs at the entrance to each cemetery will be erected. Rule changes were made to improve mowing and weed trimming thus allowing for improved cemetery appearance.

Finally, we want to improve our weed trimming operations at Calvary. To that end, we are looking for 1-2 people to trim weeds up to a total of 15 hours a week. The hourly pay for this will be \$13.00.

Thanks for the parish support for our cemeteries!
