Here is the latest update on the 2021 Diocesan Annual Appeal in relation to our parish: As of **5/24/2022**, the pledged to date is **\$61,075** which is **91.92%** of the target from **240** parish households out of approximately 750. There is **\$5,800** left to pledge. We need the support from all our parishioners to at least reach and exceed the target. Any money over the target is returned to the parish to support the parish budget. When you send in your pledge card and/or donation, you can send it directly to the diocese. Please remember that if the balance is not paid by June 30th, it will have to come out of the parish checking account which is used to pay expenses.
