The parish received word from the diocese that our parish exceeded its target amount for the Inspired by the Spirit campaign. As of December 15th, the total amount pledged came to \$588,259 which is 101% of the target amount of \$580,000, and several more pledges have been sent to the diocese since then. Thank you very much to all who pledged and have made contributions! Once the target amount has been met, the ratio changes to 80% goes to the parish and 20% to the diocese. As money is sent to the diocese, the Diocesan Annual Appeal will be satisfied first. After that amount is met, money will be paid monthly to the parish so that it can take care of the projects so designated in the campaign.

Holy Family Parish has been recognized for its outstanding effort by the Office of Social Ministries in La Crosse.
