Dear Parishioners,

The first week of July 1st and 2nd, 2023, the mission appeal will be taken for Franciscan Capuchins of Mary Queen of the Peace Province, Tamil Nadu, India. **Rev. Kabiriyal Arulanandam OFM Cap., (Father Kabiriyal)** will be here to celebrate mass and preach and do the mission appeal.

The Franciscan Capuchins are working in 106 countries in the world bearing witness to Christ after the model of St. Francis of Assisi. They are a mendicant order involved in evangelizing and serving the Ordinary and the less privileged. The Capuchin province of Mary Queen of Peace Province in Tamilnadu, India is involved in varied ministers within India and all over the world.

The Capuchins work as pastors, taking care of the spiritual needs of the faithful in 12 parishes in Tamil Nadu, India. They also undertake regular preaching and confession ministry in varied dioceses across India. Along with spiritual care, they are also pioneers in counselling ministry in Tamilnadu, helping children, youth and families. They run care-centers for mentally challenged men who are abandoned, orphan children, and addicted men. They serve in enhancing mental well-being, guided by the motto that there is no health without mental health.

The Capuchin Fathers from Tamilnadu, India also serve as missionaries in 7 parishes in Zimbabwe (Africa) instilling Christian faith and building the lives of the less privileged for the last 40 years. They are working for the last 12 years in the war affected areas of Sri Lanka rebuilding their lives from destruction and trauma.

Dear Brothers and Sisters, we request your collaboration and supportive hand in the mission of the Capuchin Fathers of Tamilnadu, India. We thank you in advance for your goodness and generosity in reaching out to the less privileged in a faraway country. May the Good Lord bless you all.
