Prairie Catholic is happy to announce the **Saints Scramble Golf Fund-raiser** will be held on Saturday, May 6th at the Prairie du Chien Country Club. There are two divisions for your consideration.

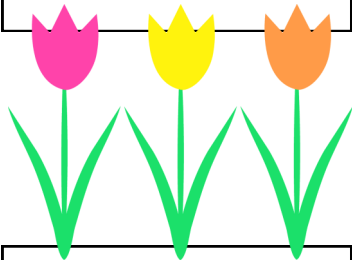
