Safety Patrol – Thanks to Police Chief Chad Abram for coming to Prairie Catholic and swearing in the 8th Grade Safety Patrol students.

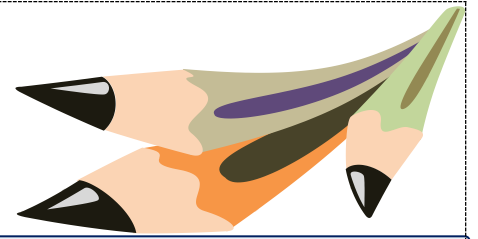
