**Graduation Date** – Information gathered from parent surveys - graduation will be held on Sunday May 17<sup>th</sup> at 4:00pm.

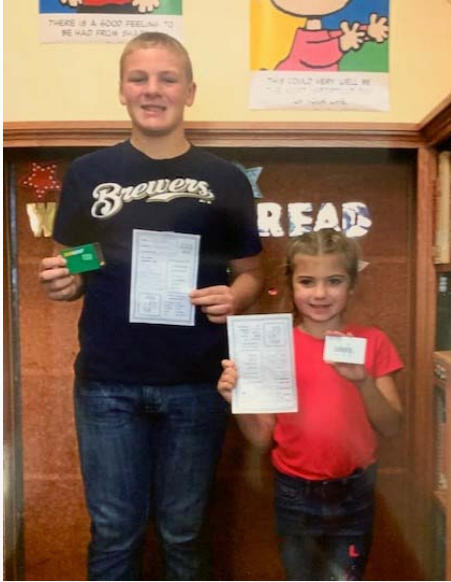
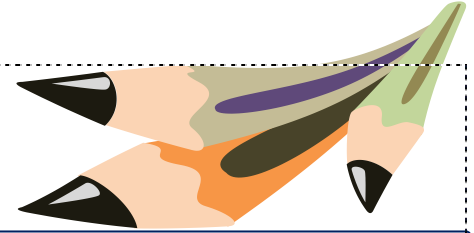
