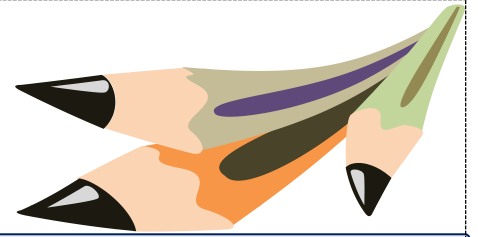

Truancy – Just a reminder that each student is allowed 10 sick days per YEAR. Partial days are counted in this number. If your student is absent for serious illness or appointments, please bring a doctor's note to the office and it will be noted on student's record.

Illness - We ask that your child remain at home if he/she has diarrhea, a sore throat, earache, a skin rash, an eye infection, vomiting, or an elevated temperature. Often a day at home and bed rest will prevent more serious illness, encourage more rapid recovery and diminish the opportunity of the disease spreading among your child's classmates.
