Masks - The students are all doing so well with their masks. I know it has been so hot this week-but they have been CHAMPS! So far so good going 5 days a week face to face!

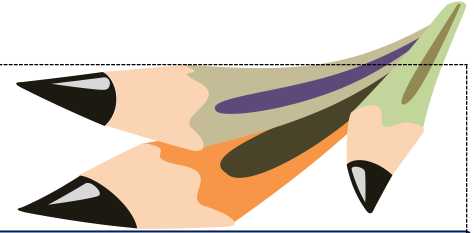

- School Communications form

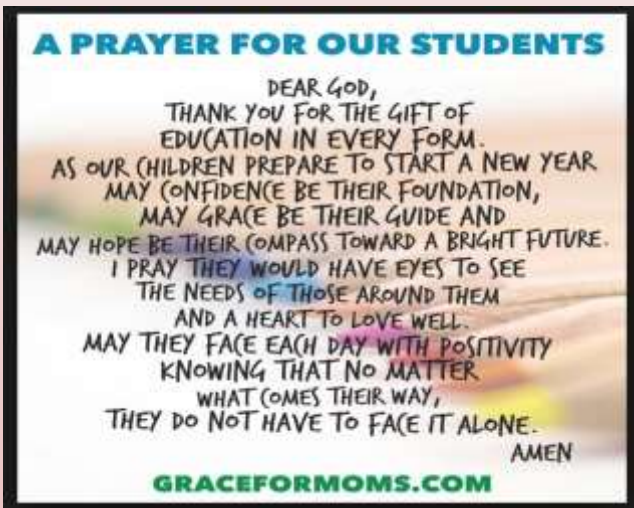
