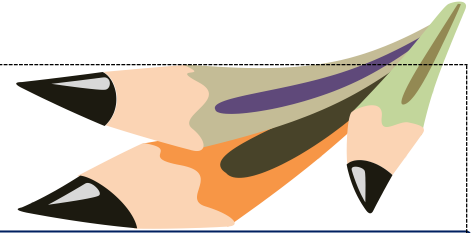

Scrip is an easy fundraiser for the school and parish. Below is the next installment of what it is and how to use it.

How is Scrip sold? Scrip is available at each rectory office (please see individual offices for hours), school office, and after each weekend mass and online. Purchasing online has never been simpler. Join our program by creating an account on MyScripWallet.com. Enter our organizations enrollment code: A2FA83875414. Then link your bank account to enroll in online payments and place your first order. Payment can also be done via a check to Prairie Catholic Scrip or use the online. Once a week the orders are placed via our SCRIP coordinator; your order will be included in this weekly order and delivered to our school and parish later that week.

Non-Prescription Medication – Please review the policy regarding Non-prescription medications.
