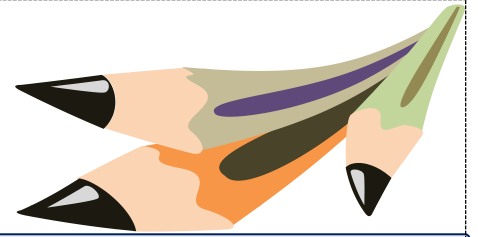
Parent/Teacher Conferences - will be held Thursday February 25st from 4:00 to 7:00pm. There will be no school on Friday, February 26th.

Mask Mandate extended – Effective January 20, Governor Evers extended the mask mandate through March 20, 2021. We will continue to wear masks.

Disposable Children's Masks – If families are interested in donating disposable children's/pediatric masks to our school it would be greatly appreciated. Non-printed plain ones are best. They can be dropped off in the school office. Thank you to all of those who have donated masks!

Colder Weather –Cold weather is here! Please send your student to school prepared to be outside for recesses. Coats, hats, gloves and boots are needed!

Truancy – Just a reminder that each student is allowed 10 sick days per YEAR. Partial days are counted in this number. If your student is absent for serious illness or appointments, please bring a doctor's note to the office and it will be noted on student's record.

Illness - We ask that your child remain at home if he/she has diarrhea, a sore throat, earache, a skin rash, an eye infection, vomiting, or an elevated temperature. Often a day at home and bed rest will prevent more serious illness, encourage more rapid recovery and diminish the opportunity of the disease spreading among your child's classmates.
