Look for places fire could start. Take a good look around your home. Identify potential fire hazards and take care of them.

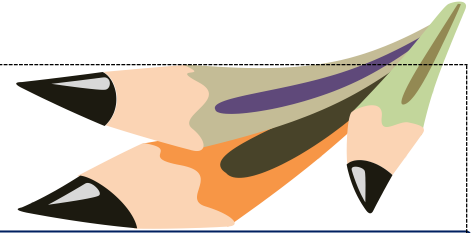
### **LISTEN**
